In response to 'The Fatal 6' initiative, the Safer by Sharing Webinars for 2020 will focus on two elements ...

### Respirable Crystalline Silica

Occupational exposure to respirable crystalline silica (RCS) can occur in any workplace situation where airborne dust, containing a proportion of respirable crystalline silica, is generated. This can get deep into the lungs and lead to the respiratory disease silicosis, a severely disabling lung disease.

Representatives from MPA members Trolex, 3M UK Ltd and Hanson will provide an expert insight into different aspects of the issue – including the potential health effects and the means to monitor, assess, control and prevent exposure to RCS.

The session will cover awareness, control and good practice as well as demonstrating the selection, use and range of respiratory protective equipment.



### Workplace Transport and Pedestrian Interface

Every year, there are over 5,000 accidents involving transport in the workplace.

About 50 of these result in people being killed. The main causes of injury are people falling off vehicles or being struck or crushed by them. These statistics are indicative of what we see within our own sector and have been identified as one of "The Fatal 6" High Consequence Hazards.

Gordon Dick of Rock & Road Training will help identify what can be done, in terms of people, plant and processes to prevent the chance of being run over or struck by a workplace vehicle. The webinar will also cover key aspects of the new guidance from the MPA Working Group on Workplace Transport and Pedestrian Interface – expected to be published later in the year.
